We provide Year Round Supplemental Youth employment and training opportunities for **Native Hawaiian, Native American Indian, and Alaska Native youth ages 14-24 years old.**

- **Youth Program Services** are outreach; intake; assessment of skill levels; career planning/counseling; development of individual employment plan; facilitation of remedial education, tutoring, study skills training, occupational skills training (including Dual Credit assistance allowing high school students to enroll in college classes, and earn credit toward high school graduation & a college degree), internships/paid work experiences, on-the-job training, entrepreneurial training, alternative secondary school services, supportive services, leadership development opportunities, financial literacy education; cultural job readiness/employment preparation; educational incentive allowances; job search and placement assistance; follow-up services; etc. Dream Navigator Career Planning System on-line and workbook incentive program.
- **Eligibility** – Must be Low-income individual based on Federal Program income requirements; Selective Service verification (all males age 18-25); 1<sup>st</sup> Priority – Veterans & Eligible Spouses of Veterans.
